Locations	There are 3 locations including a Main Library. There is also a mobile library, and a separate performing arts center.
Staff Size	There are approximately 70 employees with the majority of them being full-time staff.
Community	Rockford, Illinois, is a vibrant community brimming with opportunities for residents and visitors alike. With a rich history and a thriving arts and culture scene, Rockford offers something for everyone. From exploring fascinating museums to indulging in delicious local cuisine, there's always something exciting to discover. The city boasts a diverse range of outdoor recreational activities, making it an ideal destination for nature enthusiasts.
